DESIGN PROBLEM

The design problem is to plan and design the overall area of a community park, properly applying base, vertical and overhead plane elements, materials, features etc.





PROJECT INTRODUCTION

It has a distinct shape with its bent form, and has a perimeter of 335.47 meters and an area of approximately 6,500 sqm. The main areas is composed of the following; (1) Picnic Area, (2) Bicycle Area, (3) Small Plaza, (4) Lounge Area, (5) Theme Garden, (6) Parking Area, and (7) Playground. Entrances can be found on all sides of the park, with a wide main entrance located on its west side. The entrances are also located near areas where ramps can be placed for more accessibility.

ABOUT THE VICINITY

The lot is located within the Neopolitan Business Park. The Neopolitan Clubhouse is located to its north and the Wilcon Cement Center is located to its south. For the east and west sides of the lot, empty lots can be found. Major roads around the lot are Agropoli Bend in the east and Firenze bend in the south, both named after Italian Cities. Surrounding the site are roads mostly used by bicycle riders since the site is located near the Neopolitan Cycling Ground. The site is mostly surrounded by private and semiprivate properties, lacking a public attraction that can accommodate.




VICINITY MAP











TROPICAL-THEMED LANDSCAPE






SITE INVENTORY AND ANALYSIS

DESIGN PHILOSOPHY




FORM COMPOSITION STUDY

The project has a curvilinear theme that offers a smoother movement between areas of the park, achieving the goal of creating a space that dictates the movement of people.
















