MACRO ANALYSIS

RATIONALE | BULACAN & METRO MANILA

With Bulacan slowly becoming a part of Metro Manila, it is inevitable that such urbanization will contain phenomena that is typical of a growing city. The increase of crime rates in a growing city is a key observation.

In this context, Bulacan has been plagued with drug-related crimes in its province, Nestle between areas with several drug-related cases such as Pampanga and Manila, it is vital that the problem of drug addiction and dependency in Bulacan is addressed before it is further catalyand due to its surrounding areas and rapid development.

BULACAN VIS-À-VIS REGION III

Central Luzon has eight (8) DOH accredited in-patient drug rehabilitation centers, one of the main rehabilitation centers in the region is found in Navez Eigis, Dubted as the "MEGA" rehabilitation central is expected to louse 10.000 patients. Due to the great distance between Metro Manila and Nueva Ecija, the overspili of patients in NOR are not willing to admit themselves in the said center. Patients would rather opt to be contained in severely dense centers in the NCR.

In line with this, four (4) of these centers can be found in the Bulacan province. The con contration of contres in Buleara process the feasibility of a drug rehabilitation complex in the province. With Bulleara being recognized as the Northern Gateway from Manila, its location between vital areas such as the NRR and Panyanga (New Clark City & Angeles City) creates many opportunities to help both its local community and its neighboring provinces.

BULAKAN, BULACAN

Continued development is expected to be focused on the City of Malolos, along with some areas of Calumpit, Pullian, and Bulakan, due to their geographic characteristics. These areas are strategically located along national highways that connect them to other municipalities and provinces.

The construction of the New Manila International Airport in Bulakan, Bulacan accelerates the growth potential of Infrastructures (specially read and trasps networks that will comment the coastal towns to the urban centers). The rapid incom-undarization in Bulakan must be coupled with community development wherei locals are given angle support in order to able to adapt with its growing senzironment and community.
