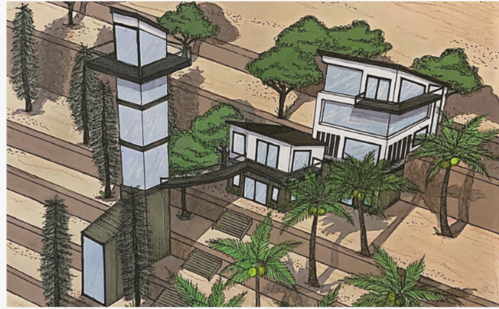


ANCHOR BAY RESTHOUSE COMPLEX

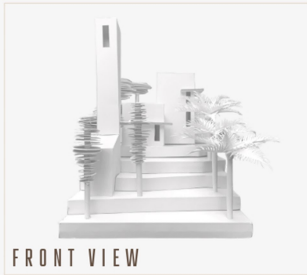

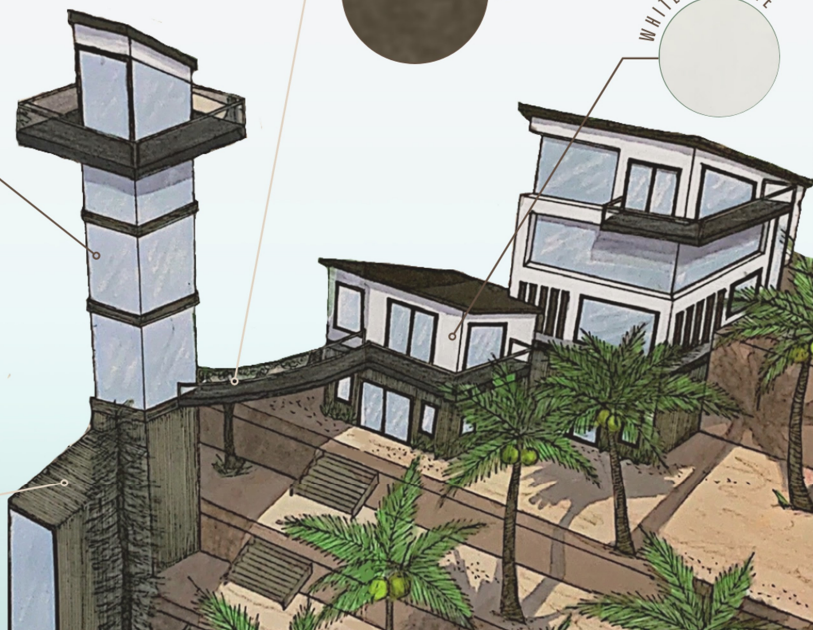

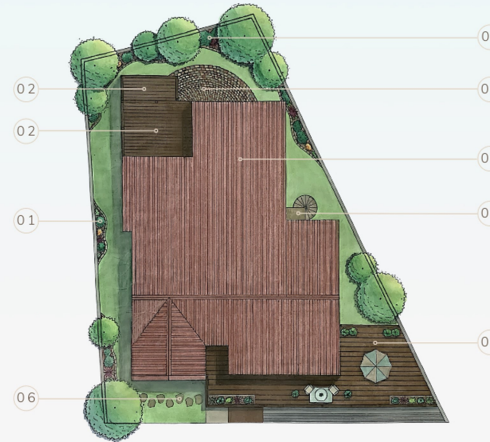

SITE ANALYSIS. The site is located in Anchor Bay, California. Anchor Bay possesses an elevation of 32 meters and is lightly populated, with 473 residents and a common camping spot for tourists. The site is along the bay, extending east into a clearing in the redwood forest on the outskirts of the beach area.

The sparse population adds to the secluded vacation feel. The project site also benefits from tourist exposure. The structures are oriented facing east to maximize sunlight at the front of the buildings for an authentic tropical vibe, while at the same time minimizing sunlight in the backyard for outdoor activities. The two environmental conditions within the site, the beach and the redwood forest, can be utilized to create two different house design styles to fit the ecological differences.

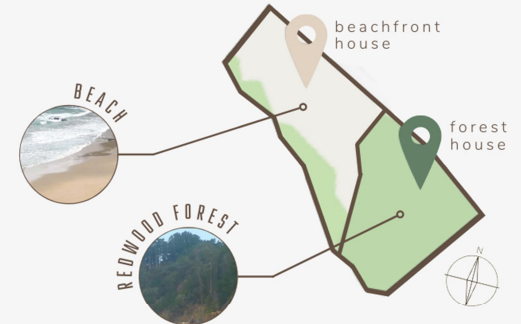
FOREST HOUSE GROUND FLOOR PLAN

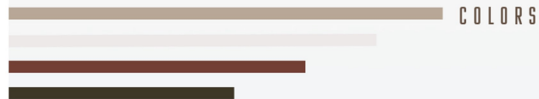
