
All the buildings are designed to provide user-specific solutions, enhancing both the human experience and the ambience of the locale. Our primary design philosophy for this project involves the balance between the complementation and juxtaposition of the various structures with their environments.











SITE ANALYSIS. The site is located in Anchor Bay, California. Anchor Bay possesses an elevation of 32 meters and is lightly populated, with 473 density of 37.4/km². The area is a spot for tourists. The site is along the

The sparse population adds to the secluded vacation feel. The project site also benefits from tourist exposure. The structures are oriented facing east to maximize sunlight at the front of the buildings for an authentic tropical vibe, while at the same time minimizing sunlight in the backyard for outdoor activities. The two environmental conditions within the site, the beach and the redwood forest, can be utilized to create two different house design styles to fit the ecological differences.
