A Proposed Mixed-Use Building for Food **Production Training, Art Learning, Health and** Recreation Center in Calamba City, Laguna

Many people have been affected by the pandemic physically, mentally and emotionally. Some have lost their jobs, others are experiencing anxiety and depression, many have not been able to exercise regularly especially in indoor spaces resulting to higher stress levels. However, based on different studies, arts can help promote well-being and create a space for social connection. Art Learning, Health & Recreation, and Artisan Food Production, oriented and focused on the users while maximizing natural lighting and natural ventilation to reduce risks of infection and anxiety. This will not only improve the mental health of the users but it will also provide additional sources of income from learning different skills.

EXISTING STRUCTURES


There are many residential, industrial, commercial and institutional buildings around the site which are all connected by the Pan-Philippine Highway and smaller roads or streets.






