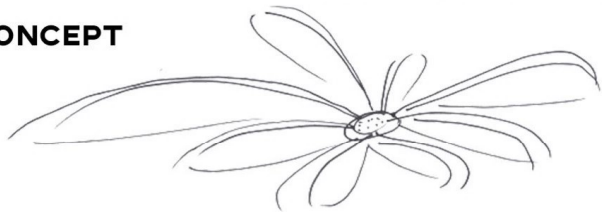

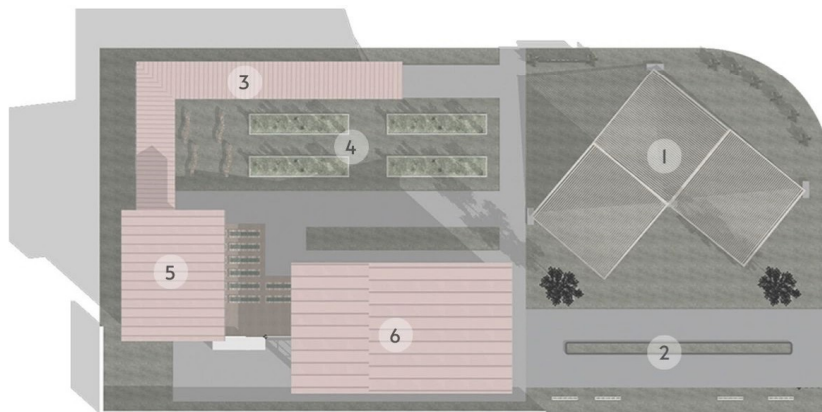

CONCEPT



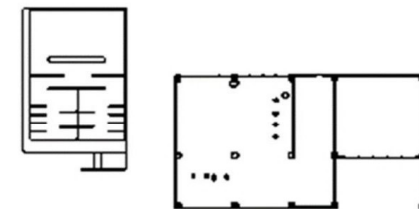

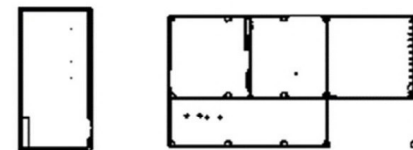
SITE DEVELOPMENT PLAN

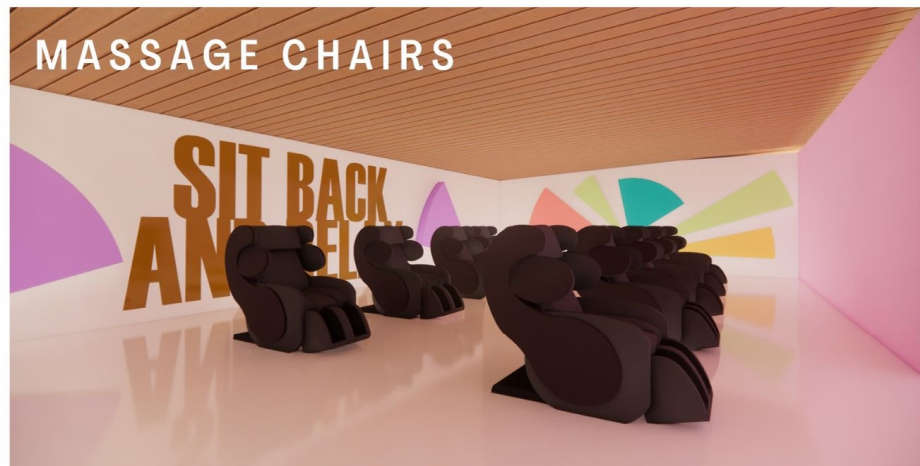
