Design Problem

LACK OF SAFE DIVERSE SPACES OUTSIDE OF FOOD ESTABLISHMENTS
THE LANDMARK HUB NEEDS TO STAND OUT BY BEING A SAFE SPACE THAT IS NOT DIRECTLY ASSOCIATED WITH EATING GIVEN THE ABUNDANCE OF FOOD SPOTS IN THE AREA

Design Solution

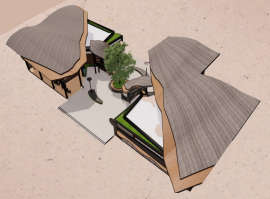

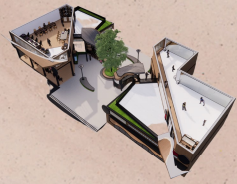

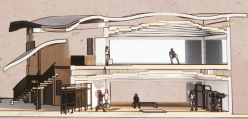

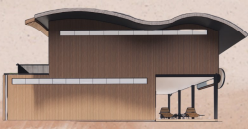

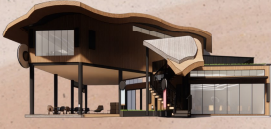

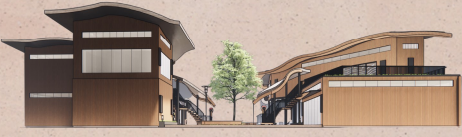

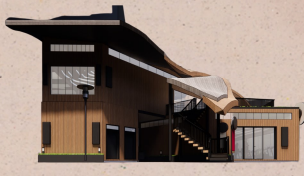

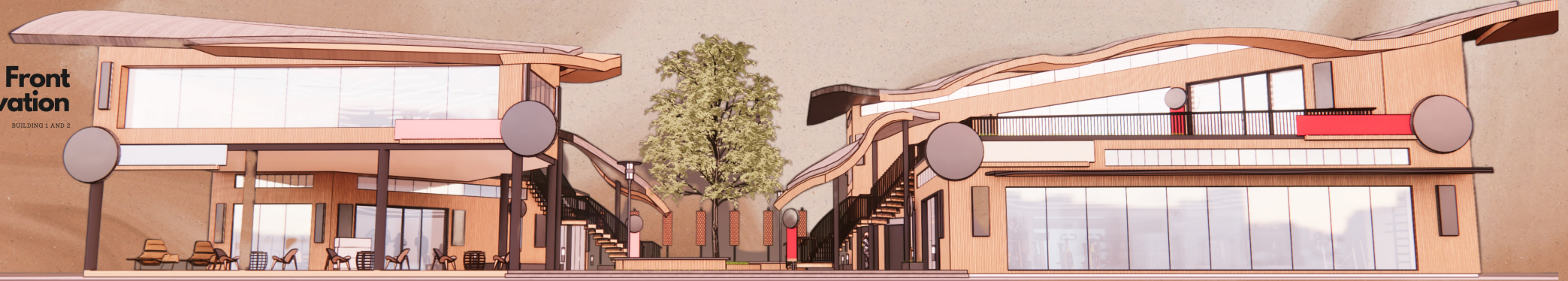

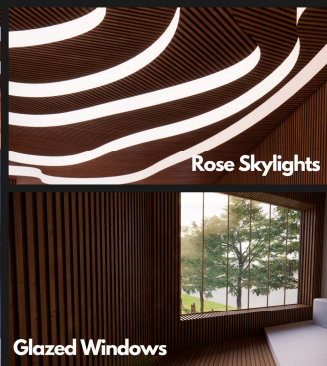
